To celebrate the holiday season, the Cape Coral Police Department is hosting our 17<sup>th</sup> Annual "Shop With A Cop" program during which Cape Coral Police Officers will pick up a child at home on the morning of Saturday, December 14<sup>th</sup> 2019 between 8:00am-8:15am. The student/officer teams will go to breakfast at McDonald's (buffet is opened at 8:30am-9:15am). After breakfast the student/officer teams will go to Walmart where they will do their shopping. A gift card provided by the "Do The Right Thing" program and our sponsors will be given to the officers and students prior to their shopping excursion. The gifts will be wrapped, lunch eaten, and shoppers returned home by the police department afterward (approx. 1:00 PM). Shoppers will be with a police officer for the entire time.

The Cape Coral Police Department will be choosing approximately 35-40 students to take shopping.

Only one child will be chosen per household. That child will buy gifts for the rest of the family as well as something for themselves.

Students will be chosen based on the financial need of the family. To qualify:

- Your child must be available on Saturday, December 14<sup>th</sup> to shop.
- Your child must be in grade Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup>.
- You and your family must live in Cape Coral.
